# POLICY STATEMENT

As a logistics service provider, we have three main objectives:

1. Providing a safe and healthy working environment for our staff and mitigating relevant environmental issues.
2. Making and keeping our customers satisfied by delivering quality and by continuously optimising our diversified services.
3. Ensuring the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of information through an effective Information Security Management System (ISMS).

Within the scope of our management system and in line with the purpose and context of our organisation, we will, as part of continuous improvement, pay attention to:

- Monitoring and optimising (renewable) energy sources, and improving energy efficiency and electrification of buildings and processes.
